STATEMENT ON COLLECTION OF PERSONAL DATA FROM

RESIDENTS OF THE EUROPEAN UNION

The Australasian College for Emergency Medicine (ACEM; the College) intends to collect personal data from you. In accordance with the College's obligations under the General Data Protection Regulations of the European Union, the College hereby gives notice of the following matters:

- the Australasian College for Emergency Medicine of 34 Jeffcott Street, West Melbourne, Victoria, 3003 Australia is the controller collecting the personal data. You can contact the College's Privacy Officer by email (privacy@acem.org.au);
- 2. the College intends to collect your personal data for any one or more of the purposes for which the College collects personal information. Without limiting the foregoing, this includes offering services to the College's members, promoting and marketing the College and the services it provides to you, facilitating the administration of the College's business, operations and activities, and complying with the College's obligations owed to statutory, government and regulatory authorities;
- 3. the College may disclose your personal data to the categories of recipients listed in the College's *Privacy Policy*. Without limiting the foregoing, the categories of recipients may include the College's external professional advisers, consultants and auditors, third party service providers and contractors (only for the purpose of providing products and services to the College), and regulatory authorities and bodies, hospitals, health centres and relevant complaints tribunals;
- 4. as the College is based in Australia, the College intends to transfer your personal data to the College's location in West Melbourne, Victoria, Australia, and to backup servers in Singapore. The College has implemented appropriate technical and organisational measures and safeguards to protect personal data transferred to Australia and Singapore.
