



## Summary of Trainee Placement Survey (2017)

October 2018

The Emergency Department (ED) Trainee Placement Survey is administered annually at the end of the training year to trainees enrolled in the FACEM Training Program. The survey is a mandatory requirement with the primary purpose to capture site-specific data to ensure that they are providing training and a training environment, which are appropriate, safe and supportive of FACEM trainees.

94%

agreed that their **needs were being met**

90%

agreed that they **had access to educational resources needed at their placement** to meet the requirements of the FACEM Training program

86%

agreed that their ED placement **provided a safe workplace**

87%+

agreed that the **number** (98%), **breadth** (91%), **acuity** (87%) and **complexity of cases** (91%) in their placement provided an appropriate training experience when considering casemix

95%

reported knowing whom to **get assistance from if experiencing difficulty**

88%

reported knowing whom to **get assistance from if they had a grievance**

51%

agreed that they could participate in **decision making** regarding governance at their ED placement

83%

agreed that **structured education sessions were provided for**, on average, a minimum of four hours/week

**Rostering was viewed positively** by the trainees:



**78%** agreed that rosters were **provided in a timely manner**



**83%** agreed that rosters were **equitable**



**82%** agreed that rosters **considered trainee workload**



**89%** agreed that rosters **supported the service needs of the site**



**87%** agreed that rosters **ensured safe working hours** and **considered staff leave requests**

agreed that the **clinical supervision at their placement met their needs**

73%

of advanced trainees agreed that they were **satisfied with the level of support received** from their Local WBA Coordinator

were **satisfied with the quality and availability** of DEMENTA support
