*What College entities or projects has the nominee been involved with? Focus particularly on those related to emergency medicine teaching and learning.*

*Detail any involvement the nominee has had in curriculum development work for the College.*

*Provide details of any not-for-profit medical education training courses the nominee has developed and/or run.*

*Detail how the nominee has mentored ACEM trainees and/or other medical educators.*

*Detail any other relevant information about the nominee's service to emergency medicine teaching and learning.*

## Submission

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Nominations must be accompanied by a citation of not more than 300 words in support of the nominee and their service in emergency medicine teaching and learning for the College. This should be a summary of the information provided on the nomination form, and, if the nomination is successful, will inform the presentation of the award at the College Ceremony.
