Direct Observation of Communication Skills (DOCS) (AEMTP)

1. Introduction

A Direct Observation of Communication Skills (DOCS) assessment is designed to provide feedback on essential communication skills pertaining to the clinical handover and/or referral of a patient. Trainees carry out a patient referral and are assessed by the supervisor who observes the process.

The Direct Observation of Communication Skills (DOCS) must be assessed by an Approved Assessor (see assessment summary page for Approved Assessor Matrix) working at the hospital.

2. Instructions

2.1 Trainees

All trainees are required to complete this assessment to a competent standard across all criteria.

2.2 Assessor

- Use the criteria and descriptors on the assessment form, with all descriptors to be shown by the trainee for each criterion. Note: Paediatric can be indicated when the patient is under 16 years of age.
- For the Global Assessment to be assessed as 'Competent' the trainee must not have been assessed as 'Not yet competent' for any individual criteria.
- Assessment (including feedback comments) can be recorded in hard copy initially, however, it
 also needs to be entered and saved in the assessment area of the ACEM Educational Resources
 website.

3. Additional information/ Tips

- Assessor must be present for the entire handover/referral process which may occur face-to-face or via phone.
- Assessor may prompt trainee or intervene to ensure safe patient care.
