## Tuvalu

- Situated in the Pacific Ocean, Polynesian heritage.
- Population over 11,000 . Funafuti has over 6,000 inhabitants (0.00015\% World Population)

- Land area: 26sq km (Hobart >65x bigger)
- British Colony until 1978
- Language, Cultures, Food



## Princess Margaret Hosp

- 50 Beds Referral Hospital
- 4 wards, *ICU, OT, OPD, ED
- Emergency Department: 1 bed with partial monitoring

## OPD / ED in Tuvalu

- 2018 data: 31,587 visits for OPD/Specialist clinic ~ 86pt/day
- ED visits??

# Emergency Healthcare services in Tuvalu 

- Trained EM staffs
- Staffs: 12 GPs (ED/OPD: 3Drs \& 2SNs per rotation 8-4pm)
- After hours: 4pm-8am on-call 1GP / 3 SNs - Whole Hospital
- Pre-hospital care services
- Specialists - Surgeon, ObGyn, Anaesthetist
- Limitations: Ventilators, USS machine, Lab tests (ABG, Trop), O2 (oxygen concentrators)


## Challenges: Prehospital Care

- Demographic spread of 9 islands
- Inter-island Medevacs
