Tuvalu

- Situated in the Pacific Ocean, Polynesian heritage.
- Population over 11,000. Funafuti has over 6,000 inhabitants (0.00015% World Population)
- Land area: 26sq km (Hobart >65x bigger)
- British Colony until 1978
- Language, Cultures, Food


- 50 Beds Referral Hospital

- Emergency Department: 1 bed with partial monitoring





Health System

OPD / ED in Tuvalu

- 2018 data: 31,587 visits for OPD/Specialist clinic ~ 86pt/day
- ED visits??
- Common ED presentations:
 Diabetic/Hypertensive emergencies
 - Sepsis

Emergency Healthcare services in Tuvalu

- Trained EM staffs
- Staffs: 12 GPs (ED/OPD: 3Drs & 2SNs per rotation 8-4pm)
- After hours: 4pm-8am on-call 1GP / 3 SNs Whole Hospital
- Pre-hospital care services
- Specialists Surgeon, ObGyn, Anaesthetist
- Limitations: Ventilators, USS machine, Lab tests (ABG, Trop), O2 (oxygen concentrators)

Challenges: Prehospital Care

- Demographic spread of 9 islands
- Inter-island Medevacs

Challenges

- Lack of Equipments
- Referral / Retrieval systems long process delaying emergency care interventions
- Need to establish & implement a Standardised Protocol for any emergency situation, applicable to Tuvalu context



Future Plans..

- Building capacity amongst ED staff & outer island Staffs
- Continue Emergency Training in Tuvalu - Nurses/Doctors: PTC, BLS, ACLS etc
- Develop Standardised Emergency Protocol
- Quality Improvement for ED
