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Things you can do

- Ask for help
- Get Educated
- Identify who to Contact
- Notify Early
- Develop and MOU with ICU
 - Don't One-way Extubate in ICU
 - Don't raise donation in ED
 - Know the MOU and how to escalate
- Provide good neurocritical care
- Integrate donation referral into ED M&M





Royal Melbourne Case Study

What the Donation Team Does for the ED

- **2+ times a year ED Reg training**
- **Regular Nurse Education**
- **Feed back on each patient who flows through ED and proceeds to donation**
- **Mediate an ED-ICU MOU on End of life care.**
- **Thank-you cakes in DonateLife week**
- **Production of an Aid-memoire Lanyard Card**



Royal Melbourne Case Study

What the ED Does for Organ Donation

- **Provides good neurocritical care**
 - Arterial Line
 - Initiation of Noradrenaline
 - Mild Peep for Neurogenic APO
 - IDC for monitoring of Diabetes Insipidus
- **Facilitates “Dying Telling” where appropriate**
- **Early Consultation with Donatelife**
 - AODR Check
 - Medical Suitability Screening
 - Demand for organs
- **Facilitates End-of-life care admissions to ICU**
- **Never raises organ donation in ED without donation specialist consultation.**

The Royal Melbourne Hospital

Criteria
Age < or = 80:

GIVE Organ Donation Trigger:

- Currently Intubated
- Unsurvivable condition
- Plan to palliate.

Eye and Tissue Donation:

- Have died.
- Have no known:
 - Hep B, Hep C or HIV
 - Haematological Malignancy
 - Neurodegenerative Condition (Eg Alzhiemers, Parkinsons)

*Please call before extubation,
or raising donation with family.*

Anyone is allowed to refer.

Doctors, Nurses, Ward Clerks!

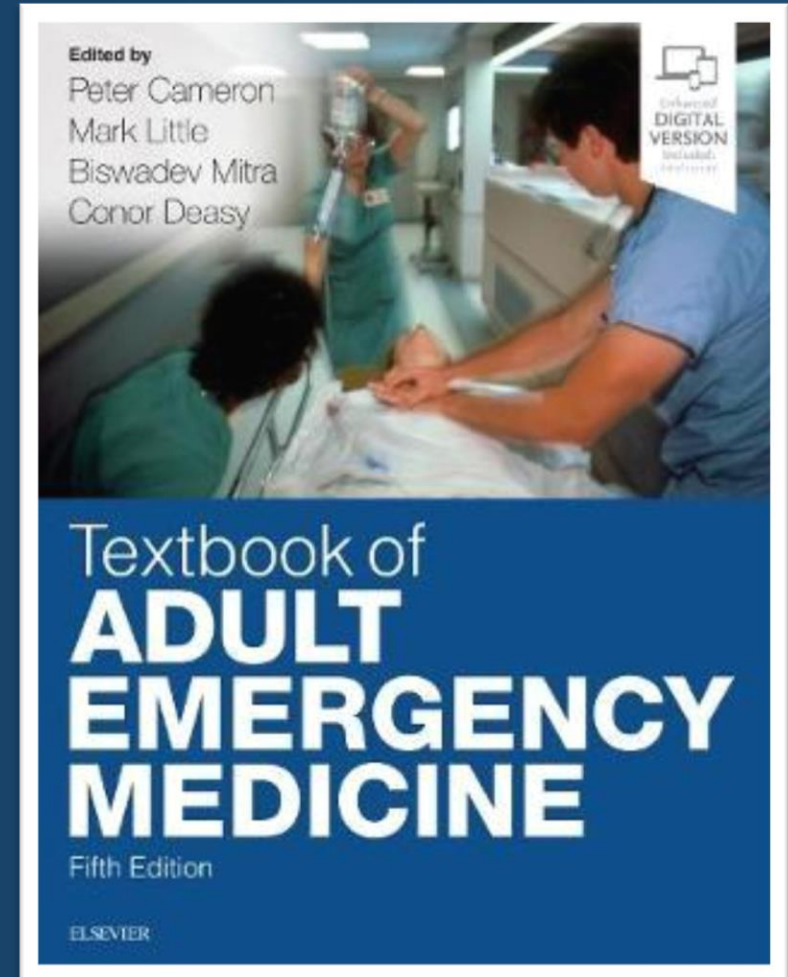
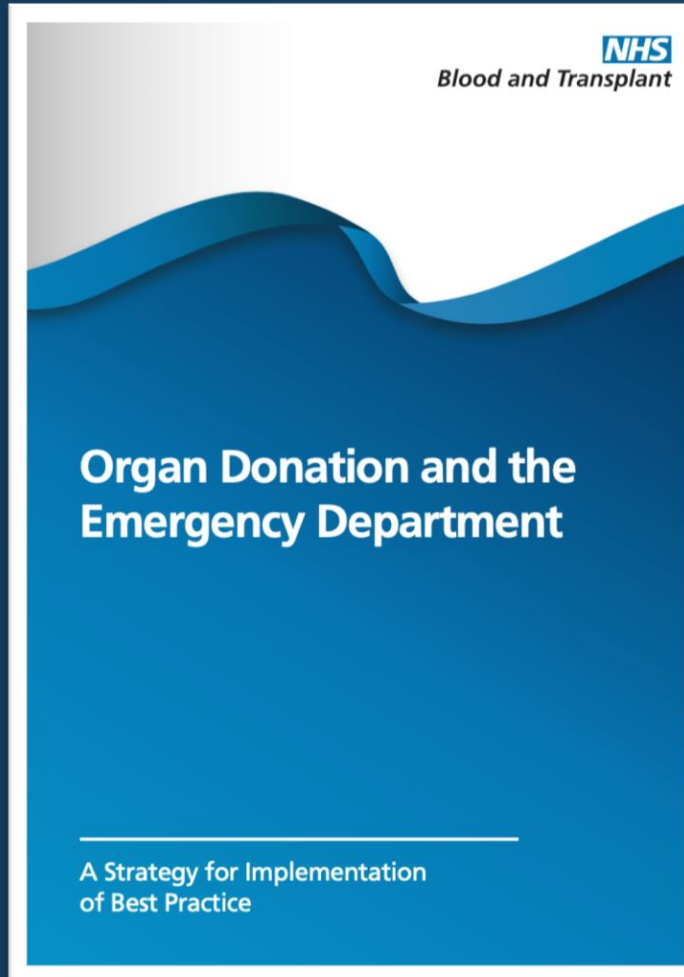
Culture & Performance

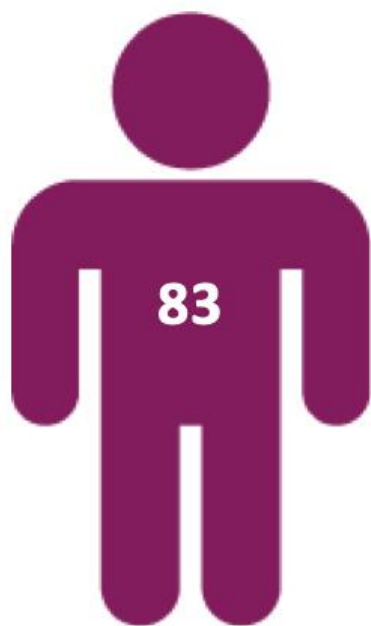
