


HOW TO ACCESS THE ACEM EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES SITE

For Health Professionals who are not ACEM members


Health professionals who are not members of ACEM can access a selection of resources on the ACEM Educational Resources site. Please follow the instructions below for access.

Note: ACEM Fellows and Trainees should login to the Educational Resources site with their Username (ACEM Member number) and Password (ACEM web password).


- 1. Click https://elearning.acem.org.au for the ACEM Educational Resources site.
- 2. Click "Create new account" to set up your ACEM Educational Resources account.



3. Fill in the details on the "New account" page, including the drop-down list for health professional role. Click on "Create my new account" at the bottom of this page.
