CRITERIA TO APPLY

This application form is for RACGP Fellows and trainees completing the Advanced Emergency Medicine Training Program (AEMTP) as part of their Additional Rural Skills Training (ARST) in Emergency Medicine during RACGP Rural Generalism specialist training. This form is for application to enter AEMTP Entry Pathway 2. The following are eligible to apply using this application form:

- RACGP trainees who have completed RACGP Core Emergency Medicine Training, or equivalent as approved by the RACGP Rural Censor; or
- Fellows of the RACGP who have completed RACGP Core Emergency Medicine Training, or equivalent as approved by the RACGP Rural Censor.

Applicants should confirm full eligibility by reading Regulation D5.1 – Eligibility for the Associateship in Advanced Emergency Medicine Training Program.

All applicants are required to complete Section A, then either Section B or C.

3. Provide a letter of completion for Core Emergency Medicine Training.
4. Provide a current Advanced Life Support 2 (ALS2) certificate or equivalent for trainees based in New Zealand, such as the Australian Resuscitation Council accredited ALS2 workshop. *Refer to approved ALS2 workshops - [FEMTP EM Skills Workshops](#).*
5. Provide proof of currency of clinical practice. i.e. current CPD activities statement
6. Provide evidence of Specialist Medical Practitioner documentation (evidence of fellowship).
