Who can attend?

The course is designed for the following groups:
Medical Practitioners, including Fellows of the College of Emergency Medicine, Advanced Trainees (in their final two years of training), Emergency Medicine Certificate holders, Senior and Chief Medical Officers working in emergency departments as the most senior clinician overnight.

Prerequisites:

If you're a Trainee you must provide a letter of support from your Director of Emergency Medicine Training, prior to your registration being accepted. Senior and Chief Medical Officers must provide us with a letter of support from the ED Director, prior to your registration being accepted.
