



Why?

Health emergencies occur everywhere in the Pacific. Currently there is limited capacity to respond



What is it / What are the components?

Effective emergency care systems can respond to all health emergencies by:



Pre-hospital care

Facility-based care



Call for help

Trained first responder

Safe transport and care

Facility reception and triage

Resuscitation and acute care by trained staff

Well designed environment and equipment

Effective processes – OT, Ward, D/C home

What are the outcomes?
